



Account Registration Form - Mail a Book *for Children and Teens*

The Queens Library provides free **Mail-a Book** service to individual customers of any age who are homebound or disabled and who have no access to a library. Books, movies and music are sent in the mail, to the reader, free of charge. Postage-paid labels for returning the books are also enclosed in reusable book bags. When books are returned to Mail-a-Book other books are automatically sent out, unless otherwise instructed. Mail-a-Book customers are not required to have a Library card, but a registration process is required. Registration will be completed following a personal phone conversation with Mail a Book to confirm your information.
